

Public meetings November 16-20 to Provide Update on Proposed Greenland Aluminium and Hydroelectric Development Project

Public meetings will be held in Nuuk, Maniitsoq, Sisimiut, and Kangerlussuaq in November to enable Greenland Development and Alcoa to report on their progress towards the establishment of a world class aluminium smelter in Greenland and to seek questions and comments on the proposed Project from anyone with an interest in this project.

ERM, the consultancy that is preparing Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) for the proposed project, along with their study partners, will present the preliminary results of the baseline EIA studies and outline the next steps in the EIA process.
